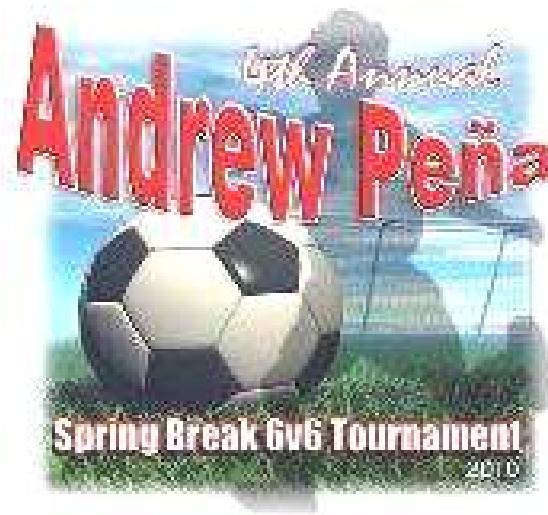

**Team Registration and Check-in:**

Team registration must be completed by submitting a tournament application via on-line registration at <http://www.boernesoccer.org>, roster **and FEES**. Application deadline is March 7. Check in will be at the field 1 hour prior to first game. All paperwork must be in order at this time.

All players (except guest players) must be registered to the team. Special requests must be included with the application. Please note on the application if you need to communicate via regular mail. Schedules will be posted late evening on March 11<sup>th</sup> if at all possible on [www.boernesoccer.org](http://www.boernesoccer.org). No team will be accepted without full payment.

We will attempt to accommodate all reasonable requests to include scheduling around a regular scheduled seasonal game if you are unable to request a bye or re-schedule. This works best if you have your seasonal game early am or late afternoon, early evening.

Teams must provide an official roster signed by association or club registrar at check in along with player ID cards for all players including guests. Three (3) registered guest players may be added per team. Teams or players without proper paperwork can not participate. Team rosters are limited to 12 players.
