



Boerne Soccer Club Competitive/Select Information 2010-2011 Seasonal Year

Fee Descriptions: In order to play on a **Thunder** competitive team, each team member is responsible for Registration, Training & Team Fees. In addition, we ask that each member consider a contribution to our Scholarship or Capital Fund so that Boerne Soccer Club (BSC) can offer financial assistance to qualified Thunder players and to maintain our facilities & equipment.

The **Registration Fee** covers Boerne Soccer Club's fees for affiliation with Regional & State youth soccer associations, supplemental insurance, field rental & maintenance fees, referee fees, and BSC operating expenses. The **Field Fee** supplements our Capital Fund with the ultimate goal of owning our own fields.

A **Team Fee (or Age Group Fee)** of \$120 per year is included as part of the registration process. This is based upon the cost of tournaments, equipment, first aid supplies, etc. associated with your specific team.

This amount may vary depending upon the number of pre & post season tournaments in which the team participates. Therefore, teams may need to impose additional assessments throughout the season. This fee belongs to the team(s), not to BSC, and is jointly managed by the team coach/manager and the BSC Treasurer.



The **Training Fee** of \$600 per year covers the cost of professionally qualified trainers (including goalkeeper trainers) for the training period.

Donation to Scholarship and/or Capital Fund: BSC's mission is to provide quality soccer opportunities for youth of all ages and skill levels - regardless of their ability to fully contribute financially. Each season approximately 12-15% of our registered players (approximately 100 players) are in need of financial assistance. Your contribution allows us to continue providing this opportunity for these individuals to play soccer. Your donations are greatly appreciated.

Payment Obligations and Schedule: The Commitment Fee of \$150 must be paid in order to reserve your roster spot. Any Uniform Fees must be paid in full prior to receipt of items. The remaining fees can be paid in full or split into installments throughout the seasonal year. Fees can be paid via cash, check or PayPal. If you choose to exercise the payment schedule option, additional fees will apply. In addition, when utilizing PayPal or paying on-line through the Club's online registration program, merchant fees will apply.



Volunteer Opt-Out Fee: Because volunteer efforts are essential to the survival of the Club, all parents are required to volunteer 10 (ten) hours of their time each year (5 hours per Fall/Spring season). Those unable or unwilling to meet this obligation can pay a \$50 "opt-out" fee per year (\$25 per season) instead. If you choose not to volunteer your time, please include this "opt-out" fee to your Commitment Fee or your Initial Payment.

Financial Assistance: Some financial assistance (FA) is available to cover a portion of the required fees for eligible players. Applications for FA are due no later than two weeks after accepting an invitation to play on a Thunder team. Aid is awarded on an available funds basis - so, apply early! Ask your team manager for more details and an application. All FA is applied to **final payments** in the payment schedule (see below), so please be prepared to make the earlier payments.
