Age Calculator

Age will be determined by the player's age as of midnight July 31 of the year in which the player could be registered for Fall season play. Teams are normally formed so that players are placed on the youngest team for which they qualify.

The following age levels will be used for the 2010-2011 seasonal year:

- Under 19 years of age - Aug. 1, 1991 to July 31, 1992
- Under 18 years of age - Aug. 1, 1992 to July 31, 1993
- Under 17 years of age - Aug. 1, 1993 to July 31, 1994
- Under 16 years of age - Aug. 1, 1994 to July 31, 1995
- Under 15 years of age - Aug. 1, 1995 to July 31, 1996
- Under 14 years of age - Aug. 1, 1996 to July 31, 1997
- Under 13 years of age - Aug. 1, 1997 to July 31, 1998
- Under 12 years of age - Aug. 1, 1998 to July 31, 1999
- Under 11 years of age - Aug. 1, 1999 to July 31, 2000
